Drawing Contest Rules & Guidelines:

MEDIUM

1. Any style of commonly used paint, water color, pencil sketch, color marker, etc. on any commonly used art paper.
2. Not to exceed 11" x 14" - not framed or backed

REQUIRED INFORMATION

1. Information submitted must be on the back of the artwork and must include: Name, address, age, correct grade in 2011, phone number, school, email if applicable, current teacher's name. Drop off or send to TFHC 219 W. 2nd St., Grand Island, NE 68801. **Entries must be received by 5pm on November 14, 2011.**
2. Must include theme "If you smoke, we all smoke."

PRIZES

1. Each First Place Winner will receive \$50 and their winning picture on a billboard. Second and Third Place will receive \$50 and a certificate for framing. 1 each in Grade School and 1 in Middle School and 1 in High School. An indefinite number of Honorable Mention Winners may be awarded and will receive a certificate suitable for framing with no monetary prize.
2. Student will give all rights to Tobacco Free Hall County to use the artwork in pamphlets, brochures, billboards, etc. in association with TFHC business as it relates to: *Education of Secondhand Smoke, Smoke Free Work Places, Smoke Free Multi-Unit Housing and General Tobacco Use and Prevention.*
3. Winners will be announced on the Great American Smoke Out, November 17, 2011. All winning artwork will be posted on the TFHC website in a story describing the contest and winners. Artwork becomes the property of Tobacco Free Hall County.
4. Once submitted, none of the artwork will be returned, however, contestants can pick up their artwork up after 12/19/2011 at the CNCAA office at 219 W. 2nd Street, Grand Island.
5. All judges' decisions are final.
